Year 1 were due to visit the theatre over the festive period, but unfortunately this was cancelled due to Covid restrictions.

A rearranged date was confirmed and the Year 1 pupils went to Oakengates Theatre in March to watch ‘Zog and The Flying Doctors’.

Miss Williams, our Music coordinator has been working hard to ensure that pupils across KS1 and KS2 are given opportunities to learn new instruments with qualified music teachers.

On a weekly basis we use Rocksteady, a company that provides tuition for a range of instruments. They make learning music fun and give the pupils the chance to be in a band, perform songs they love and learn life skills.

Miss Williams has also assembled a school choir. They rehearse after school every Thursday and are working towards a performance sometime in the summer term. The Young Voices concert is scheduled to take place in May. 25 pupils will be representing HLC Primary at this event.
